



**Built For Jesus Repair Program
Application for Assistance**

To qualify for assistance from Built For Jesus you **must**:

1. Own one residence and currently living in that residence where repairs will be made.
2. Lack the finances or resources to have the repairs completed.

In addition, you **must** meet **one** of the following criteria:

1. Be able to demonstrate the inability to pay for and/or do the repairs.
2. Have a physical disability.
3. Be a veteran or have a veteran residing in your home.

The following application must be completed in its entirety to be considered. You must also complete the list of desired repairs found on page 2 and sign the liability waiver found on page 3. In addition, you must provide proof of homeowners insurance coverage and you must also provide a copy of the two previous years income tax forms filed. Additional information may also be required as part of the application process.

The undersigned agrees and understands that the undersigned is to assume all the risks and grant this release in consideration for whatever rehabilitation or renovation work is provided to the undersigned’s residence. The undersigned fully understands that all work provided is on a voluntary basis and the undersigned agrees to accept whatever work is provided. The undersigned understands that no promises or assurances have been made that any particular work will be done or that any particular result will be achieved.

The undersigned also understands that the city in which the undersigned resides may not be inspecting any work done by the Built For Jesus Corporation.

As one of the Built For Jesus participants, the undersigned, as well as all other residents in the home, authorize the Built For Jesus Corporation (and any coordinating groups) to use and/or publish any and all photographs or videos taken the day of the event to use for reporting and/or marketing purpose (i.e., sales and marketing collateral, website, published reports, etc.).

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Built For Jesus Repair Program Frequently Asked Questions

Q: What is this program?

A: The Built For Jesus is a repair or renovation program where funds and volunteer labor is used to meet the needs of a homeowner.

Q: Who can receive assistance?

A: Any homeowner who demonstrates a basic need based on limited savings and income or the physical ability to make repairs.

Q: Who coordinates the program?

A: The Built For Jesus Corporation.

Q: Where does the funding come from for the program?

A: As a 501 (c) 3 non-profit corporation, Built For Jesus relies on donations and grants to provide the money and materials necessary to make the repairs.

Q: Are all the homeowners who apply guaranteed assistance?

A: Not necessarily. Applications are reviewed and prioritized based on repair needs and the resources available, both time and money, to make these repairs.

Q: How does someone apply for assistance?

A: An application can be brought to anyone who contacts one of the admins on the Built For Jesus Facebook page or group. These are Don Ackerman, Terry Oliphant, or Steve Anderson. Complete the form and return to the address indicated. Homeowners will need to sign a waiver of liability, plus provide proof of insurance and other information to be accepted for review.

Q: Who can sign up to volunteer to help make repairs?

A: Anyone can help make repairs.

Q: How do you sign up to volunteer to make repairs?

A: Contact one of the Facebook admins listed above for a sign-up form. This form includes a waiver of liability that must be signed. Once registered, you will be updated on upcoming volunteer opportunities.

Q: Are there any other opportunities to help besides making repairs?

A: Yes! We have folks who go and clean, provide companionship, and many other forms of ministry.
